ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Upon the accompanying complaint and attached exhibits, and all prior papers and proceedings had herein, it is hereby

ORDERED that defendants show cause before this Court at United States Courthouse, on the 29th day of September, 2003 in Courtroom 8, 11th Floor of the United States Courthouse, 225 Cadman Plaza East, Brooklyn, New York, 11201, or as soon thereafter as counsel may be heard, why an order should not be entered, or directing defendants to adjudicate plaintiffs' applications for adjustment of status on or before September 30, 2003; *at that time.*

ORDERED that the FBI shall process the plaintiffs' name checks and/or background checks immediately so that BCIS may adjudicate plaintiffs' applications for adjustment of status by close of business on September 30, 2003;

ORDERED that pending further order of this Court, the status quo shall be preserved and plaintiffs shall remain eligible for adjustment of status, and INS is enjoined from denying plaintiffs' adjustment of status applications on the basis that her eligibility for the DV-2003 program expires on September 30, 2003;

ORDERED that service of this order and supporting papers herein shall be made by personal service upon the Office of the United States Attorney for the Eastern District of New York, One Pierrepont Plaza, 11th Floor, Brooklyn, New York, 1102, no later than 5 pm on the 26th day of September, 2003.
